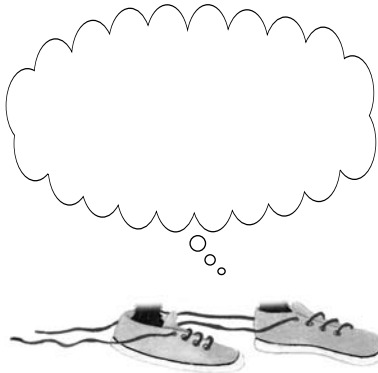


# Poetry Speaks to You and Me
